

**RESOLUTION 2019-05**

A RESOLUTION SETTING A FEE FOR CUSTOMERS DUMPING DIRECTLY INTO THE CITY OF GORDON'S WASTEWATER LAGOON.

WHEREAS, plumbers, contractors and other customers of the City of Gordon require a safe and sanitary way to dispose of wastewater collected during the cleaning of septic tanks and other wastewater collection devices, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Public Works Director, the Utility Superintendent, or their designated employee of the City of Gordon to oversee the disposal of wastewater directly into the City of Gordon's lagoon to insure the security of the lagoon and that the wastewater is disposed of in a sanitary manner, and

WHEREAS, for the purposes of this Resolution, a "load" of wastewater dumped directly into the City of Gordon's wastewater lagoon is defined as each time a City of Gordon employee must oversee a single truck dumping into the lagoon, and

WHEREAS, the city must establish a set rate in order to cover their expenses and charge applicable customers in an equal, fair, and efficient manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GORDON, that the city will charge fifty dollars (\$50.00) per load of wastewater dumped directly into the City of Gordon's wastewater lagoon. The fee will be effective May 9, 2019 and will be on file at the office of the City Clerk for public inspection.
