

PUBLIC NOTICE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE CITY OF GORDON WASTEWATER SYSTEM

Due to an increase in the groundwater level this year, and the fact that both the primary and secondary lagoons are at capacity, the Mayor of the City of Gordon has declared a bypass of the waste water treatment facility.

After consulting with our engineering firm, it was determined that there were no feasible alternatives to the bypass. The water will be tested prior to release into Antelope Creek, north of the City lagoons. Follow-up testing will be conducted at regular intervals until the process is completed.

There is no threat to the general public, or the water system of the City of Gordon and no action is required by any resident.

This process will begin Thursday, May 7, 2020 and will continue until an acceptable level has been reached.

We appreciate your understanding as we progress through this time of abnormal increases in the water flow through our system.
